Sam - Ann Aagaard (whom you visited years back with me in Bothell) is in Vermont with Knut and visited my mother's gravesite in the tiny rural village of Weybridge, Vermont - they have a grandchild graduating at Middlebury College, 6 miles from Weybridge. Ann and I worked together on a summer program in VT during college and were roommates as college seniors. She bought and placed the flowers - which is sweet - I have rarely done that. My mother's mother and grandparents were Wrights who lived there in sight of the cemetery. My mother lived with these grandparents a couple years while her father looked for a second wife when the first (Sarah Wright Hurlburt) was a pedestrian hit, dragged and killed by a car in Rutland, VT when my mother was ca 12-13 and her brother Roderic several years younger. (ca 1915 or 1916 when cars were new and driving not yet requiring competence marked by a license)
