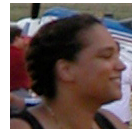

The difficulty I am trying to reconcile right now is that while the company that made the 3rd cup (Fattorini's) had a branch in Birmingham, they also had branches elsewhere, and many sources say that the branch that designed and made the cup was the Bradford branch, NOT the Birmingham branch. (They are about 150 miles apart by road.) So perhaps WLH was generally based out of Birmingham, but did a stint in Bradford?
